On January 29, 2024 the City of Wauchula Airport Advisory Board met for its regular meeting at 1:30 p.m. in the Commission Chambers, Suite 105 of Historic City Hall located at 225 East Main Street, Wauchula, Florida.

Board members present were Chairman Lavon Cobb (after roll call), Vice-Chairman Michael Gillispie, Ward Grimes, Steve Johnson and Mike Wilkinson.

Also present were Deputy City Manager John Eason and City Clerk Stephanie Camacho.

Gillispie declared a quorum and called the meeting to order.

Approval of the Agenda

Approval of the Minutes of September 18, 2023

Russ Holliday - AVCON

Holliday was present and provided updates on the items below.

AWOS II (add on item)

Holliday reported the project was completed and the close out report was being wrapped up, pending the City's submission of the FAA quarterly report and record drawings.

Taxiway A Rehab Construction Update

Holliday reported the striping was complete. He also stated an inspection of the electrical vault would be scheduled in conjunction with the power systems and arc flash study submittals/approvals by AVCON's electrical team.

Terminal Building and T-Hangar Update

Holliday reported the preliminary design on the t-hangar was complete. He also stated he had asked James Moore Architects to provide scope and fee to assist in design development, pending receipt of a price proposal from them.

Runway 36 Feasibility Study Update

Holliday reported the justification portion of the study was complete and submitted to FDOT for review. The next stage will be the environmental section.

Runway 36 Extension Update

Holliday reported that AVCON's biotech teams had been performing necessary surveys and would be wrapping up field work soon.

Hangar Repairs from Hurricane Ian Update (add on item)

Holliday reported that AVCON is not currently retained to work on that project. He stated the City has been working diligently with the insurance company and AVCON has been assisting as best as they can.
